Travel Award Program – Overview

The Canadian Nutrition Society (CNS), thanks to the funding from Calea, is pleased to offer two (2) travel awards to PhD or MD/PhD students, and post-doctoral/medical/clinical fellows. This award aims to defray costs associated with attending the 2017 CNS Annual Conference being held in Montréal, Quebec.

Funds Available

Each recipient will receive up to \$1,500 to help offset costs related to registration, travel, accommodation, and ground transportation.

Eligibility

Candidates wishing to submit an application must:

- Demonstrate an affiliation with a Canadian Home TPN program
- OR**
- Be in clinical practice providing TPN (RD, RN, pharmacist, or MD)

Candidates must be attending a conference for the purpose of presenting data (paper or poster presentation) from a home TPN related project on a first-author or presenter basis.

Application Submissions - All applications must include:

- Applicant CV
- Project summary (including relevance to home TPN)
- Budget (outlining funding required)
- Supervisor letter of support

A CNS Sub-committee has been established to review the applications and select the two awardees.

Timelines

- Application Deadline: March 27, 2017
- Results announced: April 14, 2017
- CNS Annual Conference dates: May 25-27, 2017

Payment process

Acceptance letters will outline the funding process to submit expenses for repayment (to a maximum of \$1,500/award). Official CNS expense forms (including original receipts) and banking information must be submitted within three weeks of the completion of the conference to enable reimbursement.
